




Computer

- ENIAC was the first programmable, electronic, general-purpose digital computer. It was Turing-complete and able to solve "a large class of numerical problems" through reprogramming.
- The CDC 6600, released in 1964, is generally considered the first supercomputer
- The Kenbak-1, released in early 1971, is considered by the Computer History Museum to be the world's first personal computer



Thomas Edison and Joseph Swan both invented Light Bulb





Aeroplane
